President's Report, Eric -

National Regatta Review – There were various comments on the Friday, Saturday, Sunday format and the 6-mile rule/3-hour limit. Sam said that the Fri-Sun format allowed the organizer to get better PRO and volunteers, and that he thought the class rules allowed for shorter races. 6-mile races were not necessary for a fair competition as separation occurred in much shorter distances. Farr 40 class, larger and faster, raced much shorter distances. John liked the Fri-Sun format. Richard said that the crew, Paul, was able to get home sooner, but did not affect trailering the boat. 6-mile rule was intended to make sure that it was a fair competition. Ken thought that Sunday races took away from the Saturday dinner and awards but was easier on crew. Class Trophies – Take a Bow was left in Chicago. Sam will ship it to Oxford. Sam will also update the OGLC trophy. Doug will update trophies. Cap-Don was damaged in shipping and crates/packaging were needed to protect. Class rules need to be updated with respect to trophies and 6-mile rule.
